ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

Freshmen must meet **ONE** of the following standards:

- Composite score of 20+ ACT or 1040+ SAT (UNK ACT Code is 2468; SAT Code 6467)
- Or rank in the top 50% of your graduating class
- Or have a 3.0+ cumulative high school GPA

CORE COURSE REQUIREMENTS (1 unit = 1 year)

- English 4 units Intensive reading/writing
- Math 3 units Algebra I, Algebra II, Geometry
- Social Science 3 units American/World History; History/American Government/Geography; Social Science
- Natural Science 3 units Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Earth Science; one lab course required
- World Language 2 units Same language (ex. Spanish I, Spanish II) may be substituted with additional English, Math or Science
- Elective 1 unit From the other core areas, preferably math
